Practice Safety During Christmas Season

To help ensure a safe holiday season, here are some tips from Carolyn Davis, Director Designee.

- \* Use fire resistant material
- \* Make sure trees do not block doorway.
- \* Turn off lights when you go to bed or leave the house, the lights could short out and start a fire.
- \* Keep trimmings with small removable parts out of the reach of children to prevent them from swallowing or inhaling small pieces.
- \* Avoid trimmings that resemble candy or food that may tempt a young child to eat them.
- \* Follow "artificial snow" directions to avoid lung ion while decorating.

- \*Remove wrapping papers, bags, paper, ribbons and bows after gifts are opened—These items can pose suffocation and choking hazards to children or can cause a fire if near flame.
- \*Stored decorations can accumulate dust and mold, therefore, wash or wipe ornaments and decorations before displaying.



Food Safety by Henrietta Washington, Food Manager

Bacteria are often present in raw foods. Fully cook meats and poultry, and thoroughly wash raw fruits and vegetables. Be sure to keep hot liquids and foods away from the edges of counters and tables, where they can be easily knocked over by a young child's exploring hands. Wash your hands frequently, and make sure your children do the same. And never put a spoon used to taste food back into food without washing it. Always thaw meat in the refrigerator; foods requiring refrigeration should never be left out for more than two hours.
