George Washington in 1789, declared the last Thursday of November as the Thanksgiving date.

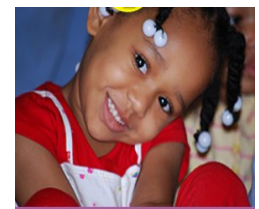
