Our theme for January is "The Weather." We have been to school together for 5 months now, and have had an opportunity to observe many different weather conditions.

First we will talk about sunny days. We will learn to make a rainbow in a jar, test the effect of the sun on art work, and create a beach in our Dramatic Play Center. We will also continue to explore the alphabet, graph weather conditions, and sort blocks by size.

Next we will discuss rainy days. We will explore water in the Science Center, give daily weather reports, and read books about rain. We will also work with shapes and paint with water colors.
